PERSONNEL POLICIES

The personnel policies of a school district are an essential part of the program of public education in a community. The philosophy of a school district and community is generally reflected in these policies.

Through its personnel policies, the Board of Education wishes to establish conditions that will attract and hold the best qualified personnel for all positions who will devote themselves to the education and welfare of District students.

Provisions for the implementation of adopted personnel policies should include channels of communication and procedures for the handling of professional and ethical problems, through which all persons or groups affected may voice their opinions.

To keep District personnel policies and corresponding administrative regulations in the highest state of effectiveness to achieve the above purposes, the District Administrator is directed to establish the procedures needed.
