

SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

A substitute teacher should be a person licensed through the DPI to teach in the schools and who is employed for short or long-term periods of time in the absence of the regular teacher.

Suitable programs for training, assigning, orienting, and evaluating the work of substitute teachers shall be provided by the instructional staff under the direction of the District Administrator.

Rates of compensation for substitute teachers will be set by the Board of Education.
