

TUTORING

It is expected that every effort will be made by the principal or elementary coordinator and teacher to help the student with their difficulties at school before recommending that parents/guardians engage a tutor. The Board of Education believes that by maintaining a high-quality instructional staff and providing for a rich, varied curriculum, the need for individual tutoring is minimized.

However, should tutoring be recommended by the principal or elementary coordinator, the District Administrator is directed to establish such rules as will protect both the District and its teachers from charges of conflict of interest.
