

ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

The success of policy 831 will depend upon the thoughtfulness, consideration, and cooperation of smokers and non-smokers. All individuals on school premises share in the responsibility for adhering to and enforcing the policy.

1. STUDENTS

Any violation of policy 831 by students shall be subject to regular student discipline procedures.

2. STAFF

Any violation of policy 831 by staff shall be dealt with based on established policies, procedures, and the Employee Handbook.

3. CITIZENS

Citizens who are observed smoking or using tobacco products or electronic cigarettes in District buildings, on outside grounds or in District-owned, or contracted for vehicles, shall be asked to refrain from doing so. If the individual fails to comply with the request, they will be referred to the appropriate supervisory staff. Continued refusal to comply with the Tobacco Free School Environment Policy will result in the citizen being banned from school property for not less than the remainder of the school year. Further violations will result in referral to law enforcement.

Signs announcing the Tobacco Free School Environment Policy will be posted in all District buildings and in District-owned or contracted vehicles.
