## SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS

## RELATIONS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

A cooperative effort shall be maintained between the officials of the District and law enforcement agencies. It is paramount that the rights of the school, home, civil authorities, and the individual be clearly understood and protected.

Specific relations between law enforcement agencies, juvenile courts, the schools, and students shall be in accord with Board of Education policy and state and federal law.

The Board of Education expects staff members and students to act respectfully toward law enforcement and armed services personnel.
