### V. Everyday Math Update – Kris Britton

K-8 Math Coach, Kris Britton, provided an update on the Everyday Math 4 curriculum that is being used in grade K-5. Everyday Math 4 is built for the Common Core State Standards and intertwines with the Standards for Mathematical Practice daily in instruction. Everyday Math 4 teaches conceptually, using visual models so students understand why the formal algorithms work, encourages multiple strategies for students, and has students actively engaged in mathematical learning. Teachers have been provided staff development during the 2015-2016. SMART board lessons have been created for teachers for all lessons in grades 1-4 to increase the fidelity of implementation. Digital support training was offered during Technology Boot Camp. Kris is continuing to provide support communicating through weekly messages and coaching opportunities.

# VI. Curriculum Writing Process – Barb Sparish

Barb Sparish provided an overview of the Rice Lake Area School District curriculum writing process. The District will be utilizing a unit plan approach to curriculum writing. These unit plans can be shared with students to help them fully understand what learning is expected. The Rice Lake Area School District Curriculum Google Site was shared with the committee. Time on each staff development day will be devoted to curriculum writing.

## VII. Staff Development Plan – Randy Drost and Barb Sparish

Randy Drost and Barb Sparish shared the staff development focus for the 2016-2017 school year. Areas focus will be on academic (curriculum) and social/emotional.
