POLICY <u>424</u> STUDENTS

ADMISSION OF STUDENTS OVER SCHOOL AGE (ADULT EDUCATION)

The administration shall not approve the enrollment or attendance in any District school or school academic program of any adult resident of the District who is no longer entitled by law to such enrollment/attendance because the adult either (1) has already graduated from high school; or (2) is no longer of school age.

All applications from such adult residents to attend school in the District shall be denied. However, if the Board of Education offers a separate program of adult education under its authority to establish and maintain community education and training opportunities outside of the regular curricular and extracurricular programs for school-age students, then such community education program shall not be subject to this policy. Instead, even if such program offers opportunities to earn academic credit, a District diploma, or a declaration of high school graduation equivalency, the program shall be subject to the terms and conditions prescribed by the District for that program, including any fees that may be charged to cover the costs of the program.
