

EMERGENCY NURSING SERVICES

The Rice Lake Area School District complies with state laws and regulations governing safety requirements and emergency nursing services and abides by the following:

- The emergency nursing policies are developed by a professional nurse(s) registered in Wisconsin in cooperation with other school district personnel and representatives from community health agencies and services as may be designated by the Board of Education.
- A physician serves as a medical advisor for the emergency nursing services.
- A review and evaluation of emergency nursing services is conducted annually by personnel designated by the Board of Education.
- Emergency information cards, equipment, supplies, and space for emergency nursing services are appropriate and readily accessible.

The District will provide each District attendance center with first aid supplies for use in emergency situations. The District will provide opportunities for staff training in CPR/AED/First Aid certification. The school district administrator, in collaboration with the school nurse, identifies and assigns responsible individuals to assist in providing emergency nursing services. These designees will provide care to students according to established standing order and protocols during the regular school day and report all such occurrences to the principal. This includes all activities on or off school campus.

During a sanctioned school activity on or off campus when school is not in session, such as after school hours, holidays, Saturdays, Sundays, summer vacation, or at evening functions, the event supervisor or their designee, present at the activity, will render first aid and follow illness or injury protocols.

First aid to protect the life and comfort of the student will be provided until parent/guardian authorized treatment is secured or treatment is turned over to a licensed health care provider. Following first aid for subsequent treatment is the responsibility of the student's parents/guardians.
