HOMEWORK

The Board of Education recognizes that a reasonable amount of preparation is necessary for the scholastic growth of students. Homework should have a valid educational purpose and should pertain to the objectives of the unit under study or the course being taken.

Homework assignments should be made by taking into account the age, maturity and abilities of the student as well as demands which may be made in assignments by other classes. Homework assignments should not be made as punishment nor require the use of specialized materials that discriminate against students whose family status or location makes access difficult. The emphasis of homework should be upon quality rather than quantity and based upon solid educational objectives.
