

RESPONSIBLE USE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES BY STUDENTS

The Rice Lake Area School District Board of Education believes that access to and responsible use of information technology resources (including the Internet) by students is a valuable and fundamental supplement to the educational process. As such, the Rice Lake Area School District acquires, develops, and maintains information technology resources to support the District's mission, goals, and curriculum; provide access to a variety of services and materials; and to promote communication and collaboration within the district community and the wider local, national, and world communities.

The District staff shall develop guidelines for responsible use of information technology resources by students. Such guidelines shall address the roles and responsibilities of each invested party (students, staff, and administration) in ensuring responsible use.
