## PROCEDURES FOR NAMING MAJOR FACILITIES

- 1. The Board President shall appoint an ad hoc naming selection committee. The committee shall consist of one Board of Education member, one administrator, one or more citizens from the District, one student, and one teacher.
- 2. The Naming Selection Committee shall present to the Board of Education not more than three names. The ad hoc naming selection committee may use various ways of involving the community in the process, including contests. Once names have been submitted to the Board of Education, the Board of Education will act on the submitted names within 90 days.
- 3. Major facilities (non-buildings), such as athletic complexes, are eligible to be named according to the following guidelines:
  - a. The name will be easily identifiable with the facility;
  - b. The name will not conflict with similar names of other facilities within the district or surrounding school districts; and
  - c. In selecting a name of a person, the Board of Education will give higher preference to persons who have made a significant contribution to education within the district.
- 4. If a facility is named for a person, it shall be for an individual who has attained prominence locally, nationally, or in the field of education, science, art, statesmanship, political science, or military achievement; an early pioneer of Barron County, or the State of Wisconsin; or an outstanding president of the United States of America. If a facility is named after a living person, the Board of Education shall obtain written consent from that person.
- 5. All names submitted may be rejected if, in the opinion of the Board of Education, the use of the name would not reflect the ideals and philosophy of the school district.
- 6. Existing facilities: Francis "Pug" Lund football field; Harold "Ole" Olsen Gym; Andrew Tainter, Haugen, Hilltop Elementaries; Dairy State Bank Stadium; Friess Family Community Campus; Lakeview Baseball Field; River Doc Nature Conservancy; and Warriors on Wisconsin shall remain in place and be subject to Policy 940.
