



PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND THOROUGHLY!

A child who is four (4) years of age on or before September 1, 2020 is eligible for preschool/4 year old kindergarten entrance. There is no early entrance for children entering the 4K Program. **The Rice Lake Area School District offers transportation for your child both to the 4K Program and home again.**

We are honored to provide your child’s 4K experience. Families will receive the program free of charge; however, individual **families will be responsible for the childcare payments to any host facility** partnering with the Rice Lake Area School District. Currently, we have two partnering agencies helping to provide the Rice Lake Area School District’s 4K curriculum.

Please note: Student class assignments are determined by Rice Lake School District staff and administrators based on parent input, class size, and student information. Be sure you mark your preferences (1st, 2nd, 3rd) on the registration form but keep in mind that parent preference is not guaranteed.
